# English for the Global Citizen

3-4 weeks, Full- or Part-time, 27 or 18 hours per week

This program is designed for students interested in improving their English conversation skills and experiencing, first-hand, how UBC is leading the way as one of the first universities to adopt and apply the principles of sustainability, global citizenship and society in both a Canadian context and a wider world view.

Topics include cross-cultural issues, Canadian society, living in communities, world community and human rights, employment, environment and the consumer, media and technology, climate change and the politics of food.

- Improve your conversation skills, enhance your fluency, practice pronunciation, and increase your vocabulary and knowledge of idioms
- Increase your understanding of other cultures
- Increase your knowledge of issues related to civil society, global citizenship and sustainability
- Learner-centred and task based activities allow you to collaborate with your classmates under the direction of experienced language teachers
- Classes provide language support and opportunities to explore these themes through group activities, role-play, discussion, presentations, guest speakers and field trips

**Assessment:** Assessment is based on attendance, participation and achievement.

**Admission Requirements:** Participants must have completed high school and have a beginner level of English at minimum.

**Levels Covered in the Program:** The program can accommodate elementary to proficiency levels; however, class composition is based on the number of registrants. Testing for class placement is on the first day of the program.
